Woodsafe Group acquires Munktorps Träförädling AB from Optimera Sverige AB

The acquisition is a strategic step in Woodsafe Group's long-term investment in wood processing, industrial production, and sustainable wood-based solutions for the Nordic and international markets.

Munktorps Träförädling AB has a long history and a strong market position in planing, painting, and wood processing. Through the acquisition, new opportunities are created to further develop the business with a focus on quality, flexibility, customer adaptation, and industrial growth.
